All guns must be tied before the 9 AM opening to the public on Saturday morning and remain tied until closing on Sunday at 3 PM. The needed ties are available at the front desk. Having all guns tied is mandatory.

The rules are simple:

TIE THEM

COVER THEM

OR PACK THEM

There will be no refunds on failure to follow the rules on the safety tying of all guns. This is for the safety of everyone.

We will be using **RED Shipping Tags** to identify the guns that have been checked and tied coming into the show by the public.

Also, we will be using **GREEN Shipping Tags** for guns going out, these are marked ok to release the other information is to be filled out on individual preference. These tags can be picked up at the front desk with some shorter ladder ties to fasten them to the gun.

Please when unloading and loading be patient as we all have to work together. Also please do not load the carts over width as this blocks the aisles so others cannot pass if needed.

There will be staff stationed at the north doors to direct traffic. After 9 AM Saturday the big doors on the north side will remain closed till 3 PM Sunday.

I have made arrangements to have some people man the front doors, they will be marked for our use. The second set will be propped open. If you choose to come through the big glass, use the ones designated. The ones designated are at Gate 1, Gate 2 and Gate 3. Gate 4 is not to be used for unloading or loading.

The concession stands are still credit or debit card only.

There will be a drawing for some cash prizes on Sunday at 2:45 PM, you must still be set up to be eligible. The tickets are in your packet.



Having the guns tied is for the public's and our protection, plus it helps with insurance.

ATF Gun Show Guidelines

This notice applies to activities permitted at bona fide gun shows, as defined in Title 27 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 478.100. Federal firearms licensees ("FFLs" or "Dealers") may only sell firearms at gun shows within the State in which their licensed premises is located.

Dealers Licensed in This State

Must display license.

Must comply with all recordkeeping requirements of ATF regulations concerning acquisitions and dispositions of firearms, including the recording of the place of sale.

May dispose of handguns to residents of the State only, provided that the purchaser is at least 21 years of age and all provisions of the Brady Law are met.

May dispose of long guns to residents of any.
State, provided that the purchaser is at least 18
years of age, the laws of both States are complied
with, and all provisions of the Brady Law are met

Way dispose of firearms to any FFL.

May acquire firearms from any FFL licensed in the State and from any non-licensed individual.

May take orders of any firearm from a non-licensee and ship the same to a licensee in the purchaser's State of residence from whom the purchaser can then take possession after the provisions of the Brady Law are met.

Dealers Not Licensed In This State

Must display license.

Must comply with all ATF recordkeeping requirements concerning the acquisition of firearms.

May acquire firearms from any FFL licensed in this State and from any non-licensed individual.

way make a sale and deliver curio or relic firearms to any other FFL licensed in any State as long as there is compliance with the laws of both States.

May ship curio or relic firearms from this show to any other FFL.

May display and take orders.

Non-Licensed Residents of This State

May acquire long guns or handguns from FFLs licensed in this State, provided all provisions of the Brady Law are met.

May dispose of personal firearms to any FFL.

May acquire from and dispose of personal firearms to non-licensed residents of the State. However, non-licensed individuals may not be engaged in the business of dealing in firearms without a Federal firearms license.

Cannot acquire from or dispose of firearms to non-licensed residents of any other State.

themselves or an FFL, a firearm that has otherwise been lawfully acquired; must, when shipping to themselves, declare the firearm to the commercial or contract carrier.

Cannot ship in interstate commerce, except to

Non-Licensed Residents From Another State

Way dispose of firearms to any FFL.

May acquire long guns only from FFLs licensed in the State, provided the laws of both States are complied with and all provisions of the Brady Law are met.

May order firearms from any FFL and have them shipped from the show to an FFL in their State of residence by a commercial or contract carrier in accordance with State and Federal law.

Cannot acquire handguns.

Cannot acquire from or dispose of firearms to non-licensed individuals.

SHOW RULES OF CONDUCT

- A. Exhibits, displays, buys, sells and trades all types of acceptable arms and their accessories, along with the Association membership and guest attendance, formulates the primary goal of this Association Show Meeting.
- B. Illegal arms and bulk explosives shall not be brought in the Show Meeting Hall.
- C. Only the contracted table surface or surfaces shall be the display areas. Exception can be made by show manager.
- D. No playing videos or electronic audio visual aids.
- E. An item that is considered detrimental, by the opinion of the majority Board members present, to the safety or best interest of this Association shall be barred. No loaded or strapped to oneself firearm except for authorized security personnel.
- F. All firearms including air guns must be strapped, re strapped and or made inoperable.
- G. DTGCA recognizes a "Zero Tolerance" to any Discharge of a fire arm, accidental or otherwise.
 - Show manager has authority to determine who is at fault.
 - If fault lies with table vendor, vendor is ejected indefinitely from all association shows.
 - If fault lies with the table vendor, the vendor has a right to appeal to the Board of Directors.
- H. Badges will be distributed by the show manager to all authorized attendance and security at the beginning of set up for the show.
- Contracted space shall be well maintained by its renter from garbage and refuse.
- J. If a show is sold out, all "no show tables" will be open until 10:00 a.m. Saturday morning, then allocated via a waiting list in numerical order.

* Air Weapons

*Smokeless Powder

Only in factory sealed containers no larger that 8# containers

* Archery Equipment

⇒ Bayonets

 Cartridges & Shotshells for Collectors

* Gun Parts, sights, gun repair supplies

* Pole Arms & Battle Axes

* Military uniforms and directly associated accourtements related solely to conflicts in which the United States was involved. Said items are to be individually displayed on mannequins or fully laid out on tables. No such items are to be stored, displayed or sold in bulk or from clothes racks.

*American Cowboy, Indian Weapons & Personal

Artifacts (Antique only)

*Firearms of all legal types

≠Firearm Curiosa

≠Knives, Swords & Daggers

*Military weapons & direct weapons related items

≠Powder Flasks & Horns

*Paintings, Pictures, Prints & Statuary-covering items on this list (jewelry not permitted)

*Reloading Tools and Supplies

*Belt Buckles-Dealing with items on this list only.

*Scrimshaw-Dealing with items on this list only.

*Bumper stickers are prohibited from all gunshows.

An exception: stickers may be sold or given away by non-profit organizations whose purpose is to promote shooting or gun ownership: stickers must be shooting or firearms related.

Prohibited Items:

*Smoke bombs

#Blow Guns

≑Black Powder

*Communication equipment

*No dummy ammunition in firearms

*Martial Arts items (Ninja), examples: throwing stars, numb chucks, throwing balls, etc.

*Parts, kits, manuals, instruction books, etc for the conversion of legal items to illegal items, or the making of bombs, silencers, machine guns, etc.

* Any form of media on government overthrow or anarchy, including anti-semidry or bigotry items.

*All items prohibited by the organization rules shall be banned from the show and must be removed from the facility.
